1.0 Transcription of letter to Antoine Charles Cazenove, Jan 5, 1809 A.L.S

Washington 5th Jan. 1809

Dear Sir

I thank you for & return your cousin's interesting letter. Still my opinion is against the probability of a speedy general peace.

By direction of Mrs G. I return the lace of which she has taken 2 1/2 yards. I believe she will return the shoes(?) by same opportunity which will take your Spectacles back, of which only one pair tortoise at 5 dollars is taken. The silver(?) mustard did me no good at night. Apples and tumblers arrived safe.
