 - any other documents required by the UMSL Financial Aid Office.
- If you are self employed, please submit Schedule C from your Federal Tax Return.
- All tax returns must be signed. If a signature line is not provided, please sign name at top of the form.
- Acceptable tax forms include IRS forms 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, 1040NR, and 1040PC. Other acceptable tax forms include IRS 1722 (With supporting detail), RTFTP Letter, 1040TEL, Puerto Rican Tax Return, or a foreign tax return.
- If you have questions about completing this form, please contact the UMSL Financial Aid Office for assistance. If information on this worksheet is different than information on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) you may be required to submit additional documents for clarification. If corrections of your FAFSA information are necessary, UMSL will electronically send those corrections to the federal processor who will send you an Information Acknowledgment 2009-2010 Student Aid Report for your records.
- If you were required to furnish information about your parent(s)*** income on the FAFSA then you are **DEPENDENT**.
