## Notice: Transition from Winmedia Streaming Services to Kaltura



To provide our customers with more robust technical solutions, Information Technology Services now provides Kaltura as the campus open source video solution. Kaltura replaces Windows Streaming Services: winmedia.umsl.edu. Your Media has been copied over to your “My Media” account in Kaltura .

The Kaltura tool is a video storage solution available in MyGateway (Blackboard). Kaltura has a few different purposes: it can store video files from your computer that you wish to share with students; it can be used to record instructor lecture videos; and it can be used as a tool for students to record videos.

After May 30th Windows Media services will no longer be available. If you have course links or web sites linked to winmedia.umsl.edu you will need to replace these links with the new links pointing to your Kaltura “My Media” account.
