Admission Requirements

Program applicants must have the following:

- Baccalaureate degree.
- 3.0 grade point average (students with exceptions should contact the director of the gerontology program).
- Official transcripts of all previous undergraduate/ graduate work.
- Two letters of recommendation.

Students already enrolled and in good standing in another masters or doctoral degree program at the University of Missouri – St. Louis should consult with the director of the gerontology program concerning streamlined admission options. Limited course substitutions may be acceptable to meet degree requirements. Substitution decisions are made at the discretion of the Program Director.
