

# Information Systems and Technology, Minor

Available to all students except those pursuing the Bachelor of Science in Information Systems and Technology degree. A minimum of 15 credit hours are required for the minor. Students must complete INFSYS 2800 and four elective courses. At least three of the elective courses must be 3000-level or higher Information Systems and Technology (INFSYS) courses. The fourth course can be any related course from Accounting (ACCTNG), Entrepreneurship (ENT) Finance (FINANCE), International Business (INTL BUS) Management (MGMT), Marketing (MKTG), Supply Chain and Analytics (SCMA), Computer Science (CMP SCI), or a related discipline subject to approval from the department chair. ~~Students must complete:-~~
