

Joint Engineering Program Admission

Admission

Students are admitted to the upper-division program after they have completed an acceptable pre-engineering program. The pre-engineering program can be taken at University of Missouri-St. Louis or at community colleges in the area.

Normally, admission is granted to persons who have completed the pre-engineering program with a minimum grade point average of 2.75 over all their mathematics, chemistry, physics, and introductory ~~engineering courses~~ (statics and dynamics) **engineering courses**. Students with less than a 2.75 grade point average, but at least a C, in all their science, **engineering** and **mathematics**, may be admitted on a **probationary conditional** basis. ~~These students must pass an Engineering Math Workshop with a grade of B or better, and then pass J-E MATH 3170 Engineering Mathematics in the first year with a C or better, in order to continue in the program.~~
