This unique graduate program in animal conservation is designed to educate animal conservation scientists and create new opportunities while working closely with the world renowned Saint Louis Zoo WildCare Institute. The fellowship will provide stipend and tuition fee waiver for each semester per academic year for two years (M.S. students) or four years (Ph.D. students), as well as the opportunity to apply for competitive research funds.
