



## Finding Aid of Collection M-271 Duncan Bauman Collection

**DATE:** ca. 1930 - 2002

**CREATOR:** Bauman, George Duncan (1912-2003), editor and publisher of the St. Louis Globe-Democrat

**SCOPE:** This collection contains the personal papers of G. Duncan Bauman, editor and publisher of the St. Louis Globe-Democrat. This collection contains a wide variety of objects such as personal correspondence, newspaper clippings, photos, and plaques.

**HISTORY:** Collection donated to the Mercantile Library by the Bauman family. G. Duncan Bauman began his newspaper career at the Chicago Herald-Examiner, but in 1941 he left to work at the St. Louis Globe-Democrat. Bauman rose to the rank of publisher and editor in 1967 and became one of the most respected and nationally known newspaper executives. Within the St. Louis community he was extremely influential. Politicians and community leaders sought his support and he had many friends in the business community. Always involved in local organizations Bauman sat on several boards, such as the Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce, the Health and Welfare Council, the United Way, the Arts and Education Council, and many others.

Some of the material in Special Collection M-271 may be photocopied, digitally scanned or photographed, subject to condition.
