





#### Federal Loan Funds

#### Subsidized Loan

- Start to pay back 6 months after graduation, drop below half-time enrollment or stop attending
- Does NOT accrue interest while you are in school
- Need based

#### Unsubsidized Loan

- Start to pay back 6 months after graduation, drop below half-time enrollment or stop attending
- ACCRUES interest immediately
- NOT need based

#### Parent PLUS Loan

- Start to pay back after it disburses (can defer)
- ACCRUES interest immediately
- NOT need based
- <u>In parent's name, not transferable</u>

#### Federal Pell Grant

You may use up to 600% and cannot receive the grant for more than 12 semesters or the equivalent.

# How much aid should I accept?



#### Refunds:

- Not necessarily "free money"
- Typically loan money
- "Needs" vs. "wants" when funding your education
- Refer to your bill to see how much you owe
- Net Price Calculator

#### **Summer Aid**

Must be registered for the semester.

Have **REMAINING** eligibility for Pell and Direct Student Loans after the Fall and Spring semesters.

Wait for the first day of enrollment in all sessions to have started before financial is paid out.



### Friendly Reminders When You're On Campus

  - Missouri Amendment 3, which legalized recreational marijuana, changes the series related to marijuana, not federal law




