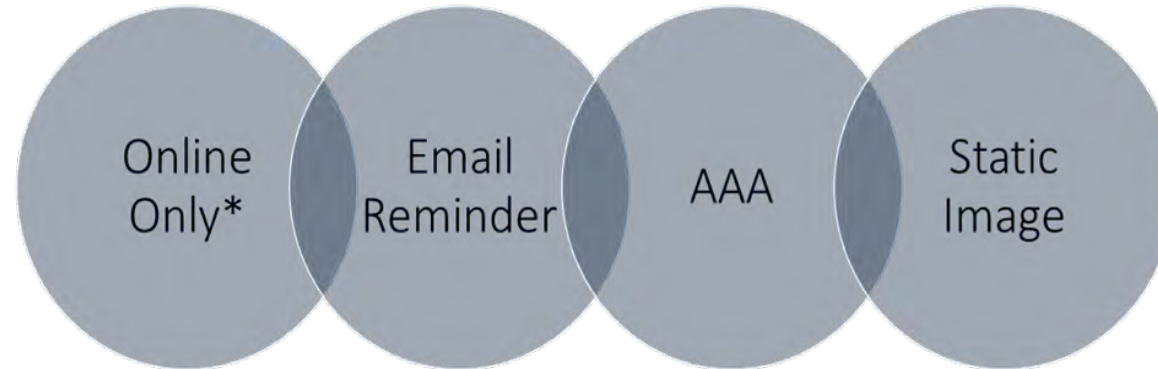

# Minimum Payment Options

Fall Semester

# Federal Loan Funds

## Subsidized Loan

- Start to pay back 6 months after graduation, drop below half-time enrollment or stop attending
- Does NOT accrue interest while you are in school
- Need based

## Unsubsidized Loan

- Start to pay back 6 months after graduation, drop below half-time enrollment or stop attending
- ACCRUES interest immediately
- NOT need based

## Parent PLUS Loan

- Start to pay back after it disburses (can defer)
- ACCRUES interest immediately
- NOT need based
- In parent's name, not transferable

## Federal Pell Grant

- You may use up to 600% and cannot receive the grant for more than 12 semesters or the equivalent.

# How much aid should I accept?



## Refunds:

- Not necessarily “free money”
- Typically loan money
- “*Needs*” vs. “wants” when funding your education
- Refer to your bill to see how much you owe
- Net Price Calculator

# Summer Aid

Must be registered for the semester.

Have **REMAINING** eligibility for Pell and Direct Student Loans after the Fall and Spring semesters.

Wait for the first day of enrollment in all sessions to have started before financial is paid out.

# Satisfactory Academic Progress



## Students must:

- Maintain 2.0+ GPA
- Complete 66.67% or more of their credit hours after the first week of classes
- Complete their degree within 150% of the credit hours required for the degree.

# 15 to Finish

15 Credit hours per semester:

- Save \$\$\$ by not paying extra tuition
- Avoid taking on more debt
- Start working and earning faster
- Up your chances for making a higher GPA
- Reduce the chance that you'll drop out

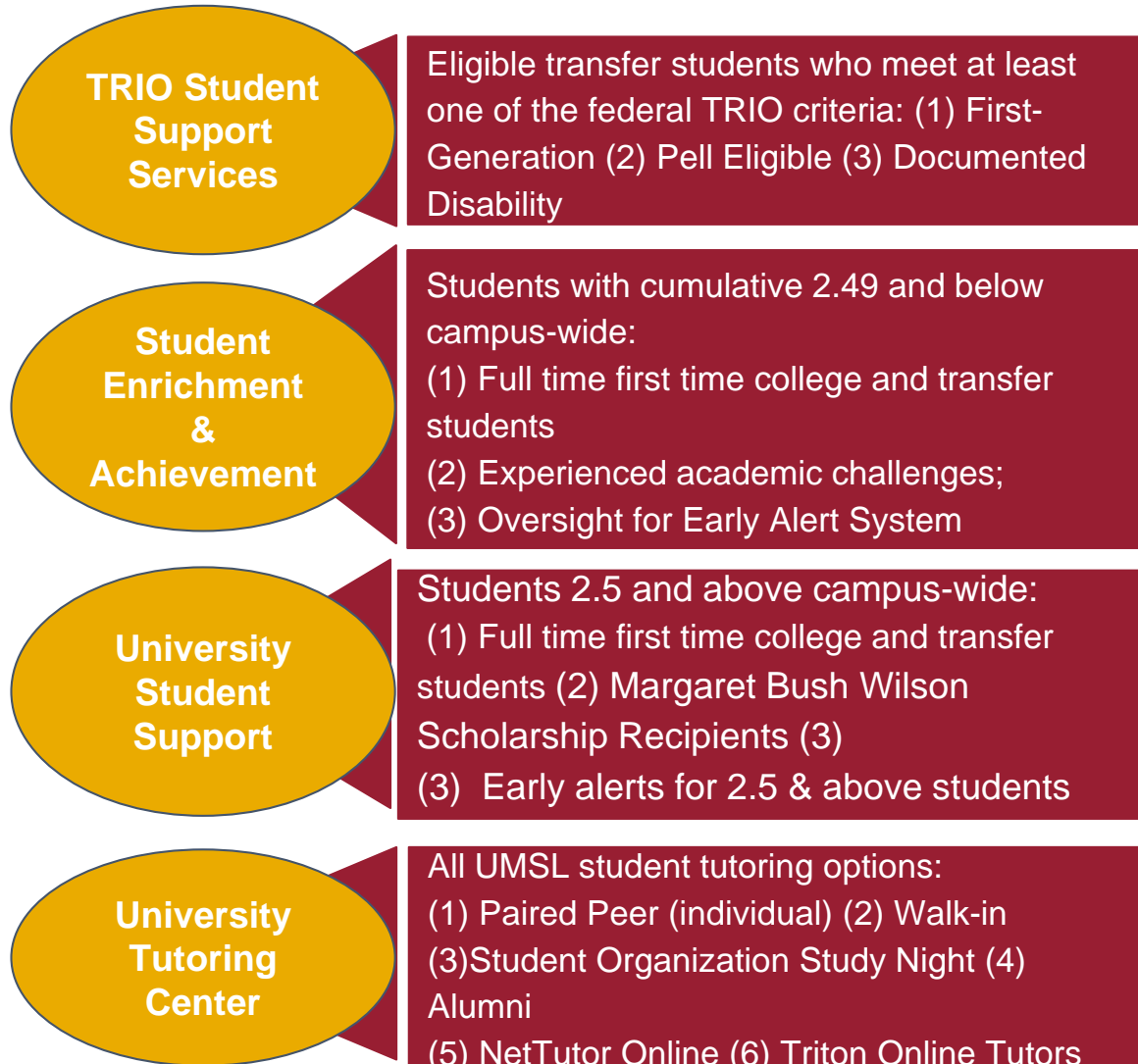

- UMSL students, faculty and staff have an added layer of security with the free Rave Guardian app that turns any smartphone into a personal safety device.
- Free to download.
- Offers speed dial functionality to reach campus police (or 911 when off-campus), a safety timer that allows friends/family to act as virtual safety escorts, and a call directory of university support services.

# Student Conduct and Academic Integrity



All members of the campus community share the responsibility to create conditions conducive to learning.

- UMSL students must adhere to community standards in accordance with the University of Missouri Standard of Conduct
- If any infractions of the Standard of Conduct occur, including but not limited to alcohol violation, plagiarism concerns, assault, students are referred to Student Conduct and Academic Integrity
  - Responsible for adjudicating and issuing sanctions
  - Relationship with UMSL Police Department, Title IX and Equity, and Academic Affairs
  - Seek to educate students in order to promote appropriate conduct and improve students' decision-making abilities

# Student Advocacy and CARE

Providing students with intervention, education, and access to resources which empower them to address barriers to academic progress and personal success.

- UMSL Student Advocacy and CARE is a team of social workers dedicated to support students.
- The Student Advocacy and CARE team can assist students with:
  - Emergency financial assistance
  - On and off campus food resources (Triton Pantry or St. Louis Food Bank)
  - Student parent support
  - Applying for public assistance or community programs
  - Assistance with identifying other resources

# Friendly Reminders When You're On Campus

- UMSL is a tobacco-free campus: no smoking or tobacco products are permitted while y
- Marijuana is not permitted on campus
  - Missouri Amendment 3, which legalized recreational marijuana, changes the s related to marijuana, not federal law
  - The Safe and Drug-Free Schools Act, which is tied to federal funding for financial aid, governs the campus
  - This also applies to residential facilities on the campus
- The open possession and discharge of firearms on campus is prohibited

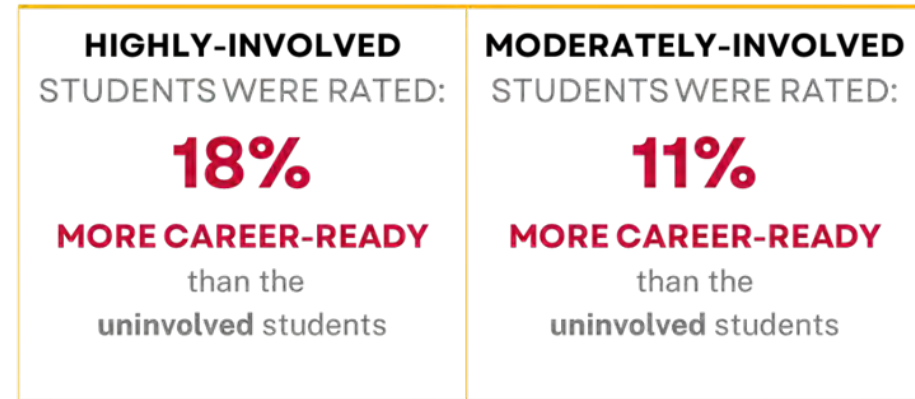
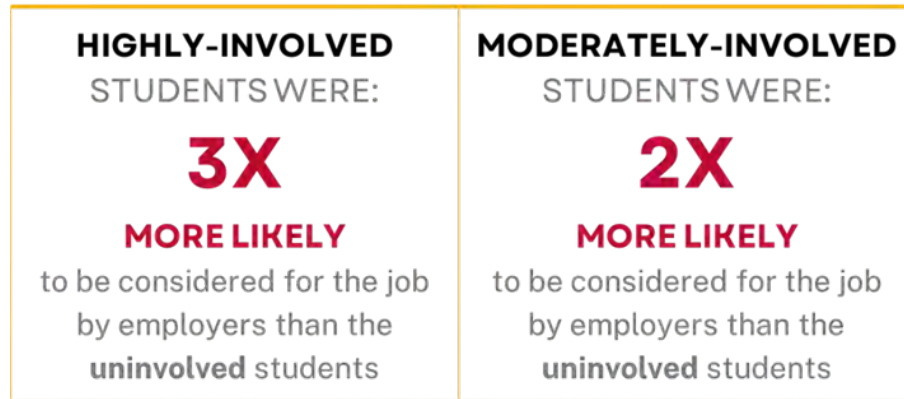

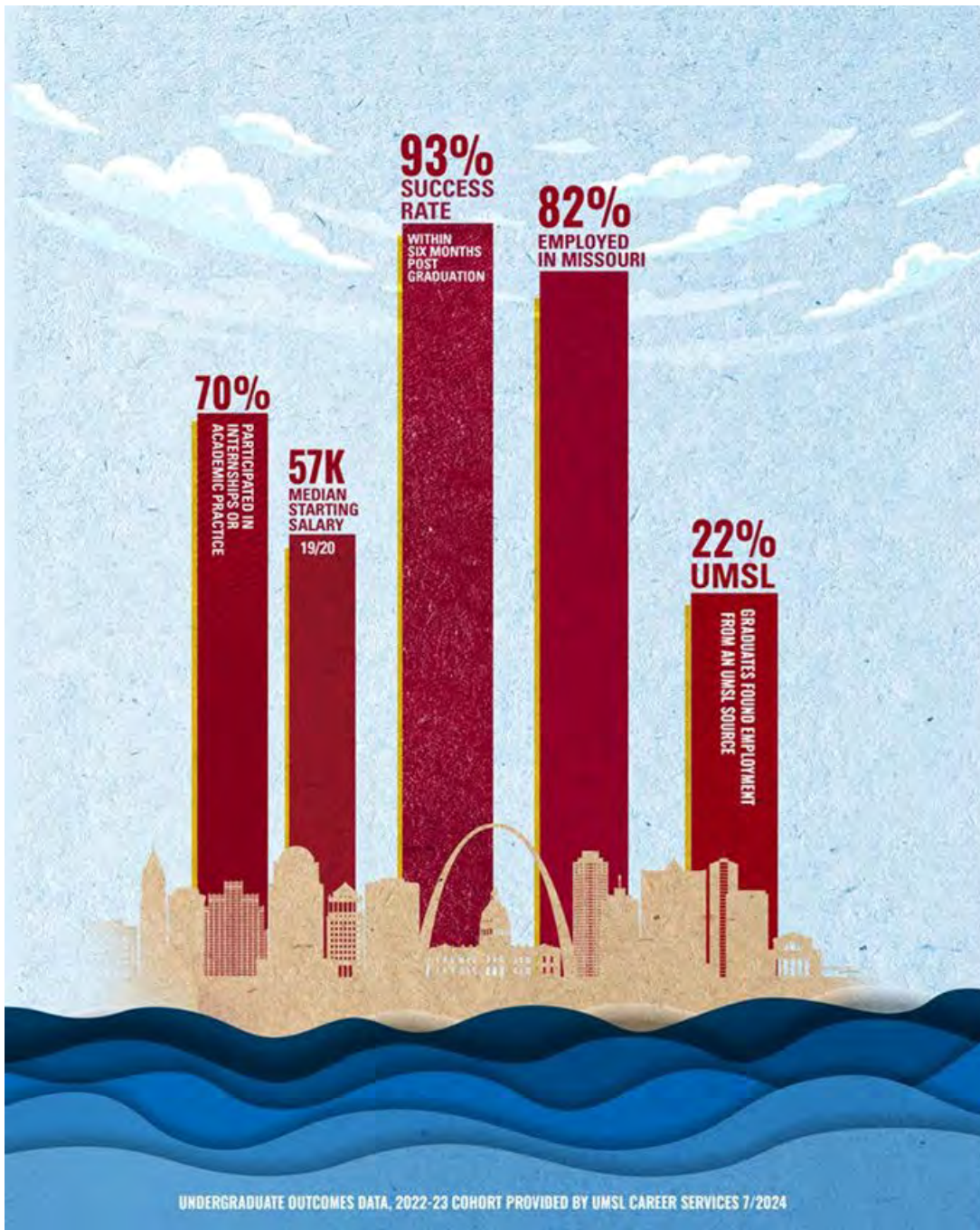
