Grant Incentive Funds

Each year, the Office of Research and Economic and Community Development returns F&A costs collected from grants and contracts during the preceding fiscal year (July 1-June 30) to the campus, RECD, principal investigators, co-principal investigators, department chairs, and authorized centers. the funds are distributed as follows:

Generally, the grant incentive funds (GIF) are put in accounts which are located within each department.

How grant incentive funds can be used:

Funds should be used to support research in accordance with existing University policies and procedures. Uses of these funds include the following:

- Funding for graduate student stipends, travel and other expenses incurred by graduate students while performing research
- Funding for postdoctoral researchers
- Research supplies/equipment purchases
- Travel to present papers, give invited talks, etc.
- Books, journals, papers and other similar expenses related to scholarship and research
- Lab enhancements for research purposes

Grant Incentive Funds (GIF) cannot be used to pay faculty salaries
