#### FROM THE HELP DESK - ANSWERS TO YOUR BACK-TO-SCHOOL FAQS:

1) I just got a new cell phone and need help with setting up Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA). What should I do?

The Help Desk can have you up and running in minutes. The best way to deal with MFA and a new cell phone is by calling the Help Desk at 314-516-6034 or by visiting them in person in the MSC, Room 190. - 2) I'm a student and don't see my course listed on Canvas. What should I do?
  - Log into Canvas
  - On the left navigation menu, click on the Courses tab.
  - Click on the All Courses Link.
  - Find your course and look at the right side of the screen to see if it is published. If it is not published, contact your instructor.
- 3) I'm a new student. What is an SSO ID?
  SSO stands for Single Sign On. For students, your SSO starts with your initials and has three random letters or numbers added. Your SSO is combined with @umsystem.edu to create your login. Example: abc123@umsystem.edu. Here is more information on SSO ID and password security.
- 4) Where should I go to look up my SSO ID or to reset my password? Go to <a href="https://www.umsl.edu/technology/password/index.html">https://www.umsl.edu/technology/password/index.html</a>
- 5) How can I create an email address that is personalized?
  You can find that information at: <a href="https://aims.umsystem.edu/">https://aims.umsystem.edu/</a>
  Log in and click on Personalize Email and choose a different email address.
- 6) How can students living on campus get their gaming devices on the network?
  - Go to <u>help.umsl.edu</u>
  - Click Login
  - Enter username@umsystem.edu and password
  - Select Report Issue
  - Select Networking & Telecom
  - Select Wireless Network
  - Select Attach a Device to the Network

UMSL now offers a campus-wide license that provides unlimited use of MATLAB and Simulink to all faculty, staff, and students on and off campus on any device. 
#### **Teams Premium**

#### **REMINDERS**

#### ARCGIS PRO ONLINE SOFTWARE AVAILABLE

ArcGIS Pro is a full-featured professional desktop GIS application from Environmental Systems Research Institute (ESRI). ArcGIS Pro enables you to explore, visualize, and analyze data, create 2D maps and 3D scenes, and share your work to ArcGIS Online or the ArcGIS Enterprise portal.

UMSL faculty, staff, and students can access ArcGIS Pro Online at <a href="https://umstlouis.maps.arcgis.com">https://umstlouis.maps.arcgis.com</a>. Once you are on the site, click UM SYSTEM SSO and enter your UMSL SSO ID and password. An account will automatically be created.

If you've used ArcGIS Pro Online previously with an ESRI username and password, that will continue to work but will be a separate account from the account associated with your SSO ID and password. If you would like to transfer content from your old account to the new SSO ID, follow these steps outlined by ESRI.

The online version of ArcGIS Pro will meet many users' needs but does lack some of the features of the desktop version. To download ArcGIS Pro, ESRI has provided this <u>video</u>. Please note that the ArcGIS Pro desktop requires a Windows PC.

#### **GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (GEN AI)**

We want to amplify this information from the Center for Teaching & Learning about Gen AI and the start of the new semester:

• Generative AI Tool Use by Students: We recommend that you clarify your policies and expectations for students regarding the use of generative AI tools such as ChatGPT as you determine what is appropriate for the learning goals for each course. We have gathered sample language you are welcome to adopt/adapt to tailor to your own context. We also recommend you include reminders about your policy in specific assignment descriptions to specify when AI use is allowed or not allowed. Want to learn more about Generative AI?
