
THE USE OF PRONOUNS IN MICROSOFT 365

SELF-SERVICE SOFTWARE UPDATES FOR UNIVERSITY APPLE DEVICES (MACBOOKS & IMACS)

For Apple devices purchased by the university, UMSL Self-Service will now automatically update applications downloaded from the <u>Self-Service hub</u>. When an application is ready to update, you will see the notification below. Quit the application using Command + Q or Quit from the application menu.



When the update is done, you will see the following notification. Once you see this message, you can open your application again. Note that applications that are not open will be updated without user intervention.
