

ITS Staff News


- In August, Brian Boyd joined the ITS Campus Relations and Communications Team as a Project Manager-Expert. Welcome to ITS and UMSL, Brian!

HOW TO CREATE A CONTACT LIST IN MAC OUTLOOK



To create a Contact List in Mac Outlook, click "people" on the left-hand rail (it's the third icon down; under mail and calendar).

Once clicked, select "Contact Lists," then "New Contact List."



Contact lists on Macs will sync up with the PC version and Outlook for web as well, so all your lists will be kept in sync no matter which computer or browser you're using.
