

F.A. Hayek Masters in Economics Student Assistantship Award

Max Gillman, *Friedrich A. Hayek Professor in Economic History*, has announced the creation of a new Graduate Award starting in the Fall of 2019.

The ***F.A. Hayek Masters in Economics Student Assistantship Award*** is being granted on a continuing basis. The Award includes a stipend; graduate tuition is covered as part of the appointment as well.

Initially, there will be no separate application. MA Applicants (or current MA students) need to simply inform the DGS (Don Kridel) that they are interested in being considered for the Award.

Subject to performance (GPA and student engagement), the Award can be renewed for a second year (based on Hayek Chair and DGS recommendations).

The Department of Economics is excited to have this additional student funding available for the recruitment (and/or retention) of highly qualified graduate students.
